Superintendent Weyant announced that County Route 105 has officially opened as of yesterday. He thanked the OCDPW for working with him and keeping him informed regularly on the status of the project. Superintendent Weyant stated the next project is the replacement of the bridge on Roselawn Road/Adrienne Drive. The work will begin after school is completed and will be done as quickly as possible. Regarding the Pine Hill Bridge, he noted the structure is maintained by NYDOT and the Town maintains the roads surface. During an inspection by NYDOT, it was determined that there are some structural concerns and the State will be repairing it. Once that all the necessary work is completed by the State the Town will then resurface the road.
