

Minutes of the Town Board Worksession held at Town Hall on April 28, 2014

**1. Discussion – Street Lights on Route 32 by Woodbury Common:**

Supervisor Burke mentioned that the most recent letter Teri Johnson of O&R sent to Town was forwarded to the board members. O&R only offers two types of LED lights; a 70 watt with 5,890 lumens and a 100 watt with 9,365 lumens. If brightness is what we are after, the letter explains that the 250 watt sodium vapor streetlights with 27,500 lumens and 400 watt sodium vapor streetlights with 46,000 lumens and where they could be placed. The work would take six weeks to complete.

Motion was offered by Supervisor Burke, seconded by Councilman Palermo to go with the brighter streetlights. The Board agreed that a lot of people walk in that area.
