REOPENING PLAN

THE FOLLOWING PROPOSAL IS BEING PRESENTED FOR CONSIDERATION FOR THE 2021 REOPENING OF THE CAMP REZ PROGRAM AT THE TOWN OF WOODBURY.

CREATION OF CAMP REZ COLOR PODS

Color pods are groups of 10 -15 children and 1-2 counselors that meet daily for a full week's session. The children signed up for the week will report to specific counselor and rotate to different areas of the camp throughout the day as a unit. The group will be identified by a color (t-shirt, headband, wristband etc.) to indicate the group they belong.

PROGRAM AREAS

The camp will provide activities throughout the day at designated areas around the camp to allow groups to divide and engage in camp program. These areas will be made identifiable with signs and will contain sanitary stations to allow campers and counselors to maintain Clean program areas for each group.

SANITARY PROCEDURES

Upon arriving to the camp, campers will be scanned for

temperature and daily health check to ensure the

student is healthy enough to attend the program for the day.

Campers will be required to wear masks as they travel through the camp and may remove mask when they arrive to program area with their Pod. **Sanitizing stations will be set up at every program area.**

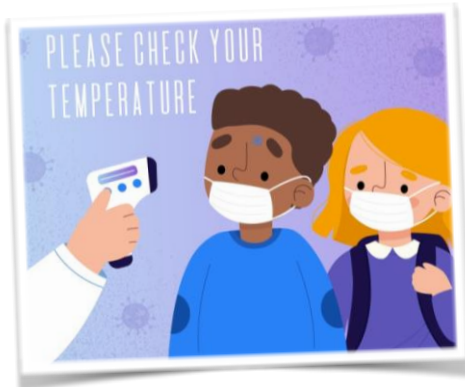




RETURNING BACK TO NORMAL STARTS WITH OUR CHILDREN

STAFF GUIDELINES

Staff will be required to wear their masks throughout the day when engaging with campers. Staff may be provided with opportunities to have a mask break so long as 6 feet is maintained from campers.



MORNING HEALTH & TEMPERATURE CHECKS

Parents and campers will be required to check temperature and answer daily health check questions to enter the program. Families will be required to sign in and out daily.
