1. February 16 Minutes:

- a. Chairwoman, Sue Lynch suggested inserting the exact date of the January meeting.

2. Parks & Recreation Director's Report - by Joey

- a. Security starts the weekend of March 26 at Rez.
- b. The Governor indicated camps can plan to be open this summer, but as of this week, there has not been any word from Orange County Department of Health.
- c. Lifeguard and Camp counselor positions are being advertised.

3. Town Liaison Report

- a. Tom said he talked to Al Fusco and was assured borings would be installed before any work is done on the pool.
- b. The Town Board plans to hire another company to do a study of the pool surface after the borings are in place.
- c. Due to the existence of asbestos, the Town Board received a price to remove the roof at the field at the Rez, and at the Pavilion at the pool.

4. Old Business

ACTION:

- a. Review of the Annual Report draft was postponed until the March work session.
- b. Joey and Buildings and Grounds will build an ice safety ladder like the one used in Central Park this winter.
- c. Chairwoman Lynch requested the Pool plans be posted on the website.
- d. A review of the revised Rules and Regulations presented by the Subcommittee is scheduled for March 24 at 7:30 pm.
- e. Joey is pricing the ice rink kit for next winter.
- f. The date for a Dedication plaque for Community Center has not been firmly set. It may take place on opening day.

5. New Business

- a. Chairwoman Lynch proposed clarifying our policies surrounding new ideas from the public. We want to encourage thoughtful input for the future and ensure that it is in line with our budget. She asked the committee to consider a policy where people provide written proposals with cost estimates if possible. This will assist Parks and Recreation committee members to develop a long-range plan.
- b. Rey asked that the committee postpone a discussion of this until the March 24 work session.
- c. Rey reported on plans for the First Responders Day. The date has been changed to June 12 with a rain day of June 19.
- d. A 5K will take place. There will be a charge for registering. Any money collected for this event will be by We are Woodbury. The proceeds will go to the Food Pantry.
