RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF WOODBURY AMENDING THE TOWN'S FEE SCHEDULE TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR PARADES AND MOTORCADES

WHEREAS, Chapter 221 of the Town Code allows, upon submission of an application and the issuance of a permit, parades and motorcades to be held in the Town of Woodbury; and

WHEREAS, the Town must carefully review each application to determine whether it is feasible to allow the proposed parade or motorcade to be held; and

WHEREAS, parades and motorcades require the presence of Town of Woodbury Police Officers and/or other town employees to ensure the safety of participants and spectators; and

WHEREAS, the Town incurs substantial costs in reviewing applications and assigning Town Police Officers and/or employees to parade or motorcade details; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that, in accordance with Chapter 65 of the Town Code, the costs to facilitate any such private parades or motorcades should not be passed along to the taxpayers;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby:

RESOLVED, that the Town Fee Schedule shall be amended to include a provision that requires a \$125 application fee and execution of an insurance/indemnification/escrow agreement sufficient to cover the Town's actual costs in facilitating all privately-organized parades or motorcades within the town.
