

**WOODBURY PARKS & RECREATION

JANUARY 21, 2020**

The Committee had concerns with the Treasurer role and would like to continue to sign vouchers each month. 4 signatures needed.
The Committee should be provided budget updates and participate in reviewing next year's budget.

Old business:

Security

Joey reported Police signed a contract with Stratagem for security cameras at both parks. It doesn't come out of Parks budget. They need internet and the feed goes into the police department.

The Committee would like to request a camera at Brickley Field.

Pool

Regarding pool user capacity, there's been no response from the Health Department yet. They have safety guidelines which are different from what the pool consultant uses for calculating capacity. This info will help residents select preferred design and should be available before the referendum.

Town Engineer will make a rendering of the pool designs. The committee would like this to happen ASAP so that the referendum can happen sooner.

The Committee will look at the renderings. Tom Burke will arrange for a workshop with the pool consultant and the town board to review the renderings before it's unveiled to the public. Plan size renderings should be posted for public view.

The swim lanes should not be painted. Ropes will suffice.

Supervisor Frank Palermo will let us know what the timing is for the referendum. The BOE has to let us know what dates Woodbury can hold a vote.

Questions to have answered:

Put together a time line!

Referendum dates – ask BOE so it doesn't interfere with primary elections.

Renderings to be provided by Town Engineer.

Is the past petition now null and void?

Work session with town board, parks committee, Town Engineer and the pool consultant.

Is this all on hold until we get it approved from the community?

Decide if the borings need to be done and get them done.

Movie night is this Friday, Jan. 24, with pizza, water and juice. Cups and jug of water preferred to bottles.

New Business:

People need to clean up after they use the community center before they get their security deposit back, including balloons or signs posted outside the center.

Park Committee would like to have recycling at the parks. There is no recycle bin. We asked Joey to call and ask what the cost of a bin is. Rey will ask a concerned resident (Martha Lopez) who is working in conjunction with the bottle depot in Central Valley. She may be interested in helping with this. The Scouts could also be approached to become involved in the community center with recycling.

Ice Skating: There is a company that makes an ice skating surface. Joey and Supervisor Palermo will look at Greenwood Lake rink to see how it works.

Mary will explore a Winter Carnival.

Mary will be in charge of a Kite Flying day this spring. Joey has the details for the day.

The Annual Pancake breakfast is on Super Bowl Sunday, February 2 at the Community Center for the John P. Burke Memorial Scholarship. It will be from 8 am to 12. The cost is \$10 pp. Children free.

A discussion about having a town Christmas tree lighting was held. If we use solar lighted trees we don't have to be concerned about electricity and it can be placed by the gates across from the diner.
