

Minutes of the Town Board Worksession held at Town Hall on September 16, 2013 at 7:30PM

1. Discussion – Letter to Public Officials Regarding Exit 131 Interchange:

Supervisor Burke explained that the Southeast Orange County Regional Traffic Task Force is reaching out to municipal and county officials for their support in seeking to help move forward the stalled approved plans to reconfigure the congested Exit 131 Interchange area. (Copies of the letters were given to the board members in their packets.) This will be an agenda item on the NYS Association of Towns, Villages and Cities meeting next Tuesday. They are trying to move up the project date from the year 2017 (the project was originally scheduled to begin in 2013). The letters are to be sent to Governor Andrew Cuomo and Congressman Sean Patrick Maloney is asking for their support in this matter. Councilman Arone suggested that letters also be sent to Speaker of the House, Sheldon Silver and the Senate Majority Leader. Supervisor Burke would like this item put on the agenda for Thursday to authorize him to sign these letters.

2. Discussion – Paperwork to Transfer Property from Town of Woodbury to Village of Woodbury:

Supervisor Burke explained that there are a between 10-15 parcels that are still in the name of the Town of Woodbury and should be transferred to the Village of Woodbury to make it official. He would like to put this on the agenda for Thursday to authorize him to sign off on this. He went onto explain that this is just a technicality and will not cost anything.
