PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on -----, at ---PM, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, a Public Hearing will be held before the Town Board of the Town of Woodbury, New York at the Town Hall, located at 615 Route 32, Highland Mills, New York 10930, inviting public comments and suggestions regarding projects to be considered for Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding under the Orange County Office of Community Development's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program. 6. Provision of Public Services (Shelters, Clinics, Senior Nutrition, etc.)
7. Payment of Non-Federal Shares of Other Grant Programs

TOWN OF WOODBURY
GOVERNING BODY FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION

The Town of Woodbury supports Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the New York State Human Rights Law. It is the policy of the Town of Woodbury to implement programs to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all person regardless of race, color, religion, ancestry, sex (including pregnancy), national origin, nationality, familial status, marital or domestic partnership status, affectional or sexual orientation, atypical hereditary cellular or blood trait, genetic information, liability for military service, mental or physical disability, perceived disability, AIDS/HIV status and Lawful Income or Source of Lawful Rent Payment (Section 8). The Town of Woodbury further objects to discrimination in the sale, rental, leasing, financing of housing or lands to be used for construction of housing, or in the provision of brokerage services because of race, color, religion, ancestry, sex, national origin, handicap or disability as prohibited by Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the New York State Human Rights Law. Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Town of Woodbury do hereby approve the following resolution.

BE IT RESOLVED, that within available resources, the Town of Woodbury will assist all persons who feel they have been discriminated against under one of the aforementioned categories, to seek equity under federal and state laws by filing a complaint with the New York State Human Rights Law and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, as appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Woodbury shall publicize this resolution and through this publicity shall cause owners of real estate, developers, and builders to become aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under the Federal Fair Housing Law, the New York State Human Rights Law, and any local laws or ordinances.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the municipality will at a minimum include, but not limited to: (1) the printing and publicizing of this resolution, a fair housing public notice and other applicable fair housing information through local media, community contacts and placement on the Municipal website and in other social media; (2) distribution of posters, flyers, and any other means which will bring to the attention of those affected, the knowledge of their respective responsibilities and rights concerning equal opportunity in housing.
