

Minutes of the Beautification Committee Meeting held on November 7, 2019 at 5:50PM.

Acceptance of Minutes:

Motion was offered by Robert, seconded by Justin, to accept the minutes of the meeting held August 1, 2019. All voted in favor of said motion and the motion was unanimously carried.

Budget Update:

There were three expenses since the last meeting:

- \$150.00 to David Anthony for flowers at the 9/11 Memorial
- \$153 and \$716 to Orange Nursery for landscaping at the new community center

Motion was then offered by Maria, seconded by Diane, to accept the Treasurers Report. All voted in favor of said motion and the motion was unanimously carried.

Old Business:

Signs - The signs planned for this year were discussed (Animal Shelter, Earl Reservoir and Library). It was decided that Maria and Desiree would go to the Printing Plus in the morning to get something finalized prior to the end of the year. The Library sign would be pushed off to next year due to all the outstanding issues. New "Welcome" signs for the north and south end of Town will be quoted as well. Justin will reach out to Dan Lux about the electric needed at the Animal Shelter for the spot lights which hopefully can be done before the ground freezes. Desiree will speak to Joseph Gianzero about the Earl Reservoir sign and what he had in mind for it.

Buena Vista - Discussion was held about maybe placing the "Welcome to Woodbury" sign at this location but it will be discussed further once the construction is complete. The Highway Department and Robert Beckley removed the tree that was there.

Storage Shed - Robert Weyant was going to help fix the front of the storage shed (possibly paving it) so it's easier to get in and out of it. Desiree will follow-up with him. There was a discussion then held about more storage space needs, especially for the street pole lights which take up a lot of space due to their size. After discussion, it was decided that a shipping container will be purchased and stored at the Reservoir near Bobby's shop. Motion was offered by Maria, seconded by Diane, to order a shipping container to be placed at Earl Reservoir at a cost not to exceed \$4500. All voted in favor of said motion and the motion was unanimously carried. Desiree will speak to Bobby and the Parks Department about it.

Holiday Decorations - Motion was offered by Maria, seconded by Robert, to approve the expenditure of up to \$4500 for the purchase of replacement, or repairs to, existing light fixtures. All voted in favor of said motion and the motion was unanimously carried. There will be a meeting on November 17 at 11AM at the Storage Shed to begin decorating for the holidays. The street pole decorations have been reported to Orange & Rockland by Desiree. She will ask the Highway Department to erect the lights during the week after Thanksgiving. Justin will look at the Central Valley Library to see what type of decorating can be done there.
